**Judicare attorneys** are private attorneys contracted to provide legal services and representation to low-income clients of a pro bono or legal aid program in exchange for payment at a reduced hourly rate.

### What would a Judicare attorney do?

- Represent low-income Hoosiers at eviction possession and/or damages hearings;
- Help tenants identify and assert defenses or counterclaims;
- Negotiate with landlords to avoid or reduce the impact of an eviction; and/or
- Provide legal advice during in-person and remote eviction legal clinics.

### What do Judicare attorneys receive?

- \$100 - \$125 per hour (up to 5 hours per case)
- Expense reimbursement for mileage and related court costs
- FREE CLE, training, and support
- Malpractice insurance coverage for Judicare cases and clinic work
